| 10C The Best Challenger Award (BCA) | | Criteria: 1. It will be calculated based on the Junior (U18) and Cadet (U15) World Ranking Points in August 2019; 2. Only one player of each category (including Junior Boys, Junior Girls, Cadet Boys and Cadet Girls) will be awarded each day (from 7th to 10th August) except the final day 11th August; 3. According to the match results of the Singles and Team Events of Boys' and Girls' Junior and Cadet, the Award will be given to the player of each category with lower points in the ranking winning the player with higher points, with the biggest ranking point difference (except those matches with player withdrawn); 4. Only results in Singles matches will be counted in Team Events; 5. The winners of the same ranking point difference would have the award; 6. | 16 SPORT CANCELLATION/ CHANGES IN NOMINATIONS To be sent to the Competition Manager | <p>Cancellation of participation is possible till August 5, 2019 at 12h local time After this deadline, the penalty policy will apply and no changes will be accepted on players' entries or team compositions.</p> <p>For cancellations after the entry deadline, a cancellation fee of 30 USD will be charged for each entered person. This period starts on the day of closing the final entries, one month before the event. These cancellation amounts will be added to the associations' invoice to be paid, together with the hospitality costs, to the organizers either by bank transfer or by cash on site.</p> <p>If cancellations occur from that time until the time of the draws and are directly notified to the ITTF Competition Manager, the Jury may decide to accept merging the remaining players (i.e. if one player from Team "A" and one player from Team "B" of the Association XXX cancel their participation BEFORE the draw is made, but after the cancellation deadline, the Jury may accept to merge the remaining players of the two teams in one Team. | 21 RACKET CONTROL | <p>If racket control includes official test for VOC miniRAE device will be used according to the ITTF decision. In this case, players will be offered the possibility of voluntary tests before competition starts. The ITTF Equipment Committee strongly recommends to all players to make certain that new racket coverings (rubbers) are aired 72 hours before use.</p> |
| 22 NUMBER OF ENTRIES PER ASSOCIATION | <p>According to 2019 World Junior Directives we have to limit the number of entries to 110 players in total. Only the final entries are taken into consideration by the organizers and the Competition Manager for the participation of your players.</p> <p>Each ITTF affiliated Association is granted with up to 3 boys and 3 girls and up to 1 team per event. However, if the maximum number of entries is not reached, there will not be limitation on the number of entries per National Association. The Host Association is entitled to 12 players in each category. Please refer to the 2019 ITTF World Junior Circuit Directives or contact the Competition Manager.</p> |
