5	ELIGIBILITY	The Championships will be open to member Associations of ATTU whose membership subscriptions have been paid up to and including the year of the Championships. The ITTF international eligibility regulations 3.8 and 4.1.3 shall apply to all team and individual Events.
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6	RULES	The Championships will be conducted in accordance with the current Laws of Table Tennis, the Regulations for International Competitions. ITTF Ranking Default Policy will be applied.
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7	SYSTEM OF PLAY	<p>Team Events:</p> <p>Team events will be divided into two divisions, namely the Champion Division and the First Division.</p> <p><u>1st Division</u></p> <p>Based on the number of entries, all teams excluding the top 6 teams from the last Asian Championships will be divided into groups of 3 or 4 teams. In the first stage, all groups play in a round robin system to determine their positions. In the second stage, group winners play in a progressive knock-out system to determine the top 2 teams (winner and runner-up) that directly enter the Champion Division. Other teams play in a progressive knock-out system to decide their final positions.</p> <p><u>Champion Division</u></p> <p>Champion Division consists of top 6 teams from the last Asian Championships in 2017 and the top 2 teams from the 1st Division. Play starts directly in a progressive knock-out system to determine the final positions.</p> <p>Match order in team events are A vs X, B vs Y, C vs Z, A vs Y, B vs X.</p> <p>All matches will be played in best of five (5) games.</p> <p>Individual Events:</p> <p>All individual events shall be played in a knock-out system. Matches in Singles events and doubles events shall be played in best of five (5) games in all stages of the competition.</p>
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8A	SEEDING LIST	<p>Team Events:</p> <p>Seeding of the teams for both Champion Division and 1st Division shall be based on the results of the last Asian Championships held in Wuxi, China in 2017. For the positions of 8 teams in the Champion Division, Team Champion and Team Runner-up of the last Asian Championships shall be placed in position 1 at the top and position 8 at the bottom of a knock-out draw respectively. Team No.3 and Team No.4 shall be drawn randomly to position 4 or position 5. Team No.5, Team No.6, and the top 2 teams from the 1st Division shall be drawn randomly to position 2, position 3, position 6 and position 7.</p> <p>For Association that did not participate in the last Asian Championships in 2017, their team ranking will be decided by the Technical and Umpire Committee of ATTU, with reference to the latest ITTF World Team Ranking.</p> <p>Individual Events:</p> <p>Seedings for individual events will be based on the ITTF September World Ranking List.</p>
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8B	FIRST DRAWS / DELEGATES MEETING	<p>The Draws will be made under the supervision of ATTU Technical and Umpire Committee.</p> <p>Draws for Team Events will take place at the Delegates Meeting</p> <p style="text-align: center;">on 14 Sep 2019 at 15:30 hrs in AMONGROGO STADIUM</p> <p>Date, time and venue of Draws for Individual Events will be announced at the Delegates Meeting. Representatives from the participating Associations are welcome to attend the draw.</p>

10 ENTRIES AND CLOSING DATES	<p>Entries shall be submitted online via the following link: http://attu.org/Onlineentry.link/login</p> <p>Online entry will start on Friday 5th July 2019. If your Association has not received the USERNAME and PASSWORD for the new ATTU online entry system, please contact Ms. Rebecca Xu at attubj@vip.163.com in order to receive your USERNAME and PASSWORD.</p> <p>An Association may nominate players as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - at least 3 players, but not more than 5 players for the Men's Team event; - at least 3 players and not more than 5 players for the Women's Team event; - not more than 5 players for Men's Singles event; - not more than 5 players for Women's Singles event; - not more than 2 pairs for Men's Doubles event; - not more than 2 pairs for Women's Doubles event; - not more than 2 pairs for Mixed Doubles event. <p>All players participating in the Men's and Women's Singles may take part in the Men's and Women's Doubles and Mixed Doubles. Pairing of doubles players from different Associations is permitted.</p> <p>Entries should be submitted before the deadlines as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Online Entry will start from 5th July 2019 - Final entries by 15th August 2019; - Accommodation and travel details by 1st September 2019. <p>In addition, each Association needs to send the accreditation photos (jpg file) for their members who will participate in the event to the organizing committee for the preparation of the accreditation.</p> <p>No additional entry is allowed after the final entry, except changes or withdrawals received by OC, ATTU Secretariat and ITTF CM before the deadline on 15th August 2019 at 12:00 hr. local time.</p>
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11 AWARDS	<p>In both Team (Champion Division) and Individual Events, the winner, runner up and losing semi-finalists will receive gold, silver and bronze medals respectively. The winner and runner up of the 1st Division Team Championships will also receive gold and silver medals respectively.</p> <p>2019 Asian Championships shall qualify one team per gender for the 2020 Tokyo Olympics. According to ITTF requirement, the Winners in the Men's Team and Women's Team in the Champion Division shall qualify for the 2020 Tokyo Olympics Table Tennis Team Events.</p>
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12 HOSPITALITY

The Organizing Committee shall provide free hospitality from lunch of **14th September 2019** to breakfast of **23rd September 2019** including board and lodging to the following:

Not more than six (6) players including playing and non-playing captain competing in both the Men's and Women's Events;

Not more than three (3) players including playing and non-playing captain competing in Men's or Women's Event only;

One (1) delegate to the Congress Meeting from each of the member Association if he/she is not included in the nominated player above;

All members of ATTU Executive Board, ATTU Honorary Officials, Chairmen of all ATTU Committees, Council Members and full members of the Technical and Umpire Committee of ATTU;

All members of the Referee Team, International Umpires and other Officials from other Associations invited in accordance with the ATTU Directive;

Members of the ATTU staff;

Chairman of the Technical and Umpire Committee of ATTU, the ATTU Secretariat Staff and ITTF Competition Manager shall be given free hospitality 3 days prior to the commencement of the Championships;

Expenses of the Chairman of the Technical and Umpire Committee or Technical Delegate including air passage to the Championships shall be borne by the Organiser;

Air passages for the Referee and Deputy Referee will be provided by the OC;

Daily allowance to the Referee Team, International Umpires and other Officials will be provided according to the Directive of ATTU;

Players and officials in the official delegation who are not entitled to free hospitality have to take the hospitality package including meals, transport and admission at a charge of **USD 130** per person per day in a twin/double room or **USD 180** per person per day in a single room.

For those Associations who cancel their entry and/or accommodation after **1st September 2019** will have to pay a charge of **USD 120** per person.

14 PAYMENT

All payment should be paid before the due date of **10th September 2019**.

The Organising Committee will send the invoice with designated bank details for payment after receiving the Accommodation Form.

All bank charges shall be covered by the Associations.

Associations who are unable to transfer payment must contact the OC before the deadline date.

15 LIABILITY

By entering the Championships, participants agree to abide by all ITTF and ATTU rules and by the rules and regulations of the Organizing Committee. All entered associations, pairs and individual players agree to be under the auspices of the ATTU and ITTF and its agents in all matters concerning television coverage, video, internet web casting, motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind.

Participants release all rights, or rights held by their agents or sponsors, in all matters relating to television and web casting coverage, video and motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind. A participant's refusal of above listed coverage may be subject to suspension or dismissal from the competition.

Any participant, when called upon, must appear promptly to press conferences or medal presentations and follow the procedures set by the ATTU and the Organizing Committee.

By entering the Championships, each Association must ensure that all delegation members confirm that they know that their personal data will be shared with the Organizers, ATTU and ITTF who, in turn, undertake not to share it with any unauthorized person in any way.

By entering the ITTF-Asian Championships, all delegation members undertake to abide by the ITTF's anti-doping rules and Anti-Harassment Policy and Procedure.

16 INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS	In the context of betting, participants shall not, by any manner whatsoever, infringe the principle of fair play, show unsporting conduct, or attempt to influence the course or result of a competition, or any part thereof, in a manner contrary to sporting ethics. Any violation of this principle shall be disciplined according to provisions of ITTF regulation 3.5.3.
17 VISA	For those who would need a visa to enter into the country, please contact the organizers to get a letter of invitation at least 2 months in advance, with: Full name, nationality, passport number with expiration date, address and occupation and also birthday and place of birth.
18 RACKET CONTROL	If racket control includes official test for VOC miniRAE device will be used according to the ITTF decision. In this case, players will be offered the possibility of voluntary tests before competition starts. The ITTF Equipment Committee strongly recommends to all players to make certain that new racket coverings (rubbers) are aired 72 hours before use.
19 INSURANCE	By entering the Championships, each Association must ensure that all delegation members have medical, travel and other appropriate insurance for the duration of the Championships.
